## FAQS

1. What is a project?

A project is a structured report on a topic, mutually agreed upon by the student and the University.

2. Are there any mandatory attendance requirements for counseling sessions?

Yes.

3. What is meant by an Examination centre?

An Examination centre means a place where examinations are conducted for the assessment of the learners pursuing the programmes, having the required infrastructure, including adequate manpower for the smooth conduct of examinations, adhering to such minimum standards as specified by the University.

4. What is Grade Point (GP) and Credit Point (CP) ?

A grade point is an integer indicating the numerical equivalent of the broad level of performance of a student in a course. Grade point means the point given to a letter grade on a 10 point scale.

Credit point (CP) is the value obtained by multiplying the Grade Point (GP) by the Credit (C) of the course,  $CP = GP * C$ .

5. What is Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) ?

It is the value obtained by dividing the sum of credit points in all the semesters taken by the students for the entire programme by the total number of credits in the entire programme, and rounded off to three decimal points.
